

Year 9 Residential to Condoover Hall 9th June to 11th June 2025

An outdoor adventure residential trip is planned for Year 9 at the above centre. Pupils will leave school at 9:30 on the Monday and return by 4pm on the Wednesday.

Activities may include abseiling, archery, canoeing, climbing, fencing, giant swing, high ropes, initiative exercises, Jacob's ladder, trapeze, orienteering, quad bikes, team challenge, vertical play pens and a zip wire.

Pupils will be accommodated in small dormitories with bunk beds and there will be clean toilets and hot showers ensuite. Bedding will be provided, however a full kit list will be provided nearer the time.

All meals will be provided apart from lunch on the first day as pupils are required to provide their own packed lunch, if your child is free school meals let me know beforehand that a packed lunch is required.

Travel will be by coach and there will be Alder Grange staff accompanying the trip. The outdoor activities will be led by qualified PGL staff. There are limited places, so it will be on a first come first served basis.

Please note that Lancashire County does not insure your son or daughter for cancellation, loss of property or personal accident. During the Spring Term full details will be given to parents and consent forms signed during a parents meeting.

The cost of the trip is **£370** (£330 for accommodation, meals & activities and £40 for transport). If you are struggling to pay please don't hesitate to get in touch, there may be something we can do.
