We encourage and enable our students to achieve their full potential academically, whilst growing as individuals too. Courses are career-driven, and our supportive environment offers students the flexibility to choose courses that suit them and to take up enrichment opportunities to learn skills away from the classroom.

ag6 provides pathways to careers

Our A-level and applied courses are built around different career aspirations and students have the option to combine alternative course options to meet their needs. We also offer alternative options for young people who need additional support but have a specific talent and show great potential - this includes extra teaching in core subjects alongside key life skills.

ag6 encourages drive and ambition

Part of our role is to help all students to identify and achieve their aspirations. They progress on to different career paths following various routes, including university courses, apprenticeships and direct entry into a chosen workplace. We encourage our students to discover their strengths and we ensure they have all the resources they need to achieve their goals. Enrichment courses such as 'Tomorrow's Teachers', provide hands-on practical sessions and have led to large numbers of former students progressing on to dream jobs.

ag6 cares about growth and wellbeing

Wellbeing and personal development are our top priority at ag6. The caring, community-feel of our sixth form also complements our pro-active approach to supporting the mental health and wellbeing of our young people. We have a wellbeing hub to signpost students to support, trained mental health and counselling support and a programme of taught sessions to develop mindfulness and resilience.

ag6 was set up to support local students and meet local employment needs. This remains our core focus, welcoming students from Alder Grange and other schools into the ag6 family.


Together is how we achieve our ambitions

1 YEAR, LEVEL 2 **PATHWAY PROGRAMME**

This is a specialist 1 year provision that will allow students to be supported through a personalised learning programme. It is tailored towards the individual's needs and abilities to allow for progression into apprenticeships or further sixth form courses.


The aim of this unique programme is to offer students considering a career in teaching either at primary or secondary school level the opportunity to gain first hand experience of what skills are needed to be a teacher.
